



Board Application

Serving on the Association of Independent Manufacturers' Representatives Board is both a privilege and an honor. This volunteer position will involve a generous contribution of your time and resources. However, past members of the AIM/R Board report that their investment was well worth it. Not only do you gain invaluable insight on our profession, board members will also interact with rep leaders from throughout the country. You will create new industry contacts for your rep firm - and make new friends.

Composition of Board

The Board of Directors consists of the Executive Committee, Officers, and eight representative at large directors. The Executive Director serves as an ex-officio member of the Board without a vote.

Qualifications to Serve

Employees of member (rep) firms in good standing are eligible to serve on the Board. Not more than two representatives from the same firm can serve on the Board at the same time.

Election & Term of Office

Six months (November) prior to the expiration of the terms of the officers and at large directors, a nominating committee is appointed by the President. The five-member committee consists of: Chairman of the Board, President, President-Elect and two Directors nominated by the president and confirmed by the Board. The committee, by majority vote, selects a slate of proposed officers and persons to fill expiring terms of office for election at the next Board of Directors meeting. The slate of nominees is to be submitted to the Board at least 30 days prior to the date of election.

The AIM/R Director term is 3 years. If a Director moves up to the Executive Committee (optional), the rotation through all 7 Executive Committee chairs typically is a 7-year commitment. Executive Committee members are not required to serve in all 7 chairs, although it is recommended.

Time Commitment

Serving on the Board requires that you attend two board meetings each year. One meeting is typically held at an industry event, such as AHR or KBIS, and the second meeting is held at the annual AIM/R Conference. The Executive Committee and Directors hold regular monthly teleconference calls. A Director is assigned to each Vice President to assist with projects. Volunteers will be solicited from time to time to serve on committees, to work on specific projects, and other association business/events.
